





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## How to get to Euratex

### From the airport:

By Taxi (15-30 min depending on traffic situation) approx. 35,- €

By Bus: Airport Bus to Square Luxembourg every 20min (travelling time 25-40 min depending on traffic + 5min walk to Euratex), 3,- €

By Train: Airport Train to Brussels Gare Centrale every 20min (travelling time 25-30 min + 10-15min walk to Euratex or at Gare Centrale change to Metro 1A/B direction 'Herrmann Debroux' or 'Stockel', exit Arts-Loi + 7-8 min walk to Euratex), 3-5 €

### From the high speed train station (Gare du Midi):

Take Metro 2 direction 'Simonis' get off at 'Trône/Troon' and take exit/sortie 'Rue Montoyer' + 2min walk to Euratex

### Arrival by car:

An underground parking space in our building can be made available. Please notify us in advance.
